8 AS INTRODUCED

9 An Act relating to the Oklahoma School of Science and  
10 Mathematics; making an appropriation; stating  
11 purpose; requiring budgeting in certain categories  
12 and amounts; requiring certain performance measures;  
13 providing for duties and compensation of employees;  
14 limiting salary of the Director; providing budgetary  
15 limitations; and providing an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma School  
18 of Science and Mathematics from any monies not otherwise  
19 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for  
20 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_  
21 Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform  
22 the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma School of Science and  
23 Mathematics by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the Board  
 2 of Trustees of the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics shall  
 3 budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

9 The Board of Trustees shall develop outcome-based performance  
 10 measures for each budget category.  
 11

12 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
 13 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
 14 upon the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics by law shall be  
 15 set by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed  
 16 \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the  
 17 fiscal year ending June 30, 2011. The Oklahoma School of Science  
 18 and Mathematics for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, shall be  
 19 subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-  
 20 equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for  
 21 capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant  
 22 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma  
 23 Statutes:
