8 AS INTRODUCED

9 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Center for the
10 Advancement of Science and Technology; making an
11 appropriation; stating purpose; requiring budgeting
12 in certain categories and amounts; requiring certain
13 performance measures; providing for duties and
14 compensation of employees; limiting salary of the
15 Executive Director; providing budgetary limitations;
16 and providing an effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Center
19 for the Advancement of Science and Technology from any monies not
20 otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State
21 Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the sum of
22 _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be
23 necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Center for
24 the Advancement of Science and Technology by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the
2 Oklahoma Center for the Advancement of Science and Technology shall
3 budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

8 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
9 each budget category.

10 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
11 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
12 upon the Oklahoma Center for the Advancement of Science and
13 Technology by law shall be set by the Oklahoma Center for the
14 Advancement of Science and Technology. The salary of the Executive
15 Director of the Oklahoma Center for the Advancement of Science and
16 Technology shall not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per
17 annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011.
18 The Oklahoma Center for the Advancement of Science and Technology
19 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, shall be subject to the
20 following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees
21 and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special
22 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of
23 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
