9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Ethics Commission; making an
11 appropriation; stating purpose; requiring budgeting
12 in certain categories and amounts; requiring certain
13 performance measures; providing for duties and
14 compensation of employees; providing budgetary
15 limitations; and providing an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Ethics
18 Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
19 General Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June
20 30, 2011, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so
21 much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon
22 the Ethics Commission by law.

23 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the Ethics
24 Commission shall budget all funds in the following categories and
amounts:

6 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
7 each budget category.

8 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
9 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
10 upon the Ethics Commission by law shall be set by the Executive
11 Director. The Ethics Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30,
12 2011, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on
13 full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding
14 expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be
15 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of
16 the Oklahoma Statutes:
