9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Merit Protection
11 Commission; requiring budgeting in certain categories
12 and amounts; requiring certain performance measures;
13 providing for duties and compensation of employees;
14 limiting the salary of the Executive Director;
15 providing budgetary limitations; and providing an
16 effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the
19 Oklahoma Merit Protection Commission shall budget all funds in the
20 following categories and amounts:

2 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
3 each budget category.

4 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not
5 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
6 upon the Oklahoma Merit Protection Commission by law shall be set by
7 the Executive Director. The salary of the Executive Director of the
8 Oklahoma Merit Protection Commission shall not exceed

9 _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for
10 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011. The Oklahoma Merit Protection
11 Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, shall be
12 subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-
13 equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for
14 capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant
15 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
16 Statutes:
