9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Office of Personnel
11 Management; making an appropriation; stating purpose;
12 requiring budgeting in certain categories and
13 amounts; requiring certain performance measures;
14 providing for duties and compensation of employees;
15 limiting the salary of the Director; providing
16 budgetary limitations; and providing an effective
17 date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of
20 Personnel Management from any monies not otherwise appropriated from
21 the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
22 ending June 30, 2011, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00)
23 or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed
24 upon the Office of Personnel Management by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the Office
2 of Personnel Management shall budget all funds in the following
3 categories and amounts:

12 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
13 each budget category.

14 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
15 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
16 upon the Office of Personnel Management by law shall be set by the
17 Administrator. The salary of the Administrator of the Office of
18 Personnel Management shall not exceed _____
19 Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year
20 ending June 30, 2011. The Office of Personnel Management for the
21 fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, shall be subject to the following
22 budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and
23 expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special
24

1 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of
2 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
