9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Tax Commission;
11 making an appropriation; stating purpose; requiring
12 budgeting in certain categories and amounts;
13 requiring certain performance measures; providing for
14 duties and compensation of employees; providing
15 budgetary limitations; and providing an effective
16 date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Tax
19 Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
20 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
21 ending June 30, 2011, the sum of _____ Dollars
22 (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties
23 imposed upon the Oklahoma Tax Commission by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the
2 Oklahoma Tax Commission shall budget all funds in the following
3 categories and amounts:

16 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
17 each budget category.

18 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
19 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
20 upon the Oklahoma Tax Commission by law shall be set by the Oklahoma
21 Tax Commission. The Oklahoma Tax Commission for the fiscal year
22 ending June 30, 2011, shall be subject to the following budgetary
23 limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures
24 excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as

1 may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of
2 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
