9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Department of Transportation;  
11 making appropriations; stating purposes; requiring  
12 transfers of certain monies; requiring expenditures  
13 for certain purposes; requiring budgeting in certain  
14 categories and amounts; requiring certain performance  
measures; providing for duties and compensation of  
employees; limiting the salary of the Director;  
providing budgetary limitations; and providing an  
effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of  
19 Transportation from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the  
20 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year  
21 ending June 30, 2011, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00)  
22 or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties set  
23 forth in Section 2003 of Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The  
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1 appropriation set forth in this section shall be transferred to the  
2 State Highway Construction and Maintenance Fund.

3 SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of  
4 Transportation from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the  
5 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year  
6 ending June 30, 2011, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00)  
7 or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed  
8 upon the Department of Transportation by law. The appropriation set  
9 forth in this section shall be transferred to the Public Transit  
10 Revolving Fund.

11 SECTION 3. The Department of Transportation shall expend from  
12 the funds dedicated to construction not less than \_\_\_\_\_  
13 Dollars (\$0.00) for the construction of roads to existing industrial  
14 sites and roads for economic development purposes, and not less than  
15 \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) for the construction,  
16 maintenance and repair of roads to historical sites and lake access  
17 roads.

18 SECTION 4. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the  
19 Department of Transportation shall budget all funds in the following  
20 categories and amounts:

10       The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for  
11 each budget category.

12       SECTION 5. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
13 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
14 upon the Department of Transportation by law shall be set by the  
15 Director. The salary of the Director of the Department of  
16 Transportation shall not exceed \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00)  
17 per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011.  
18 The Oklahoma Department of Transportation for the fiscal year ending  
19 June 30, 2011, shall be subject to the following budgetary  
20 limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures  
21 excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as  
22 may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of  
23 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
