9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Health Care
11 Authority; making an appropriation; stating purpose;
12 requiring budgeting in certain categories and
13 amounts; requiring certain performance measures;
14 providing for duties and compensation of employees;
15 limiting salary of the Administrator; providing
16 budgetary limitations; and providing an effective
17 date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Health
20 Care Authority from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
21 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
22 ending June 30, 2011, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00)
23 or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed
24 upon the Oklahoma Health Care Authority by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the
2 Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall budget all funds in the
3 following categories and amounts:

13 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
14 each budget category.

15 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
16 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
17 upon the Oklahoma Health Care Authority by law shall be set by the
18 Administrator of the Oklahoma Health Care Authority. The salary of
19 the Administrator shall not exceed ____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum,
20 payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011. The
21 Oklahoma Health Care Authority for the fiscal year ending June 30,
22 2011, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations,
23 except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section
24 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
