AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs; requiring budgeting in certain categories and amounts; requiring certain performance measures; providing for duties and compensation of employees; limiting the salary of the Director; providing budgetary limitations; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

2 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for  
3 each budget category.

4 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
5 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
6 upon the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs by law shall be set  
7 by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed \_\_\_\_\_  
8 (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June  
9 30, 2010. The Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs for the  
10 fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the following  
11 budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees, except as  
12 may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of  
13 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
