8 AS INTRODUCED

9 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Department of
10 Veterans Affairs; making an appropriation; stating
11 purpose; requiring budgeting in certain categories
12 and amounts; requiring certain performance measures;
13 providing for duties and compensation of employees;
14 limiting the salary of the Director; providing
15 budgetary limitations; and providing an effective
16 date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma
19 Department of Veterans Affairs from any monies not otherwise
20 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for
21 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the sum of _____
22 Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform
23 the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs
24 by law.

SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the
Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs shall budget all funds in
the following categories and amounts:

7 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
8 each budget category.

9 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
10 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
11 upon the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs by law shall be set
12 by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed _____
13 (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June
14 30, 2011. The Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs for the
15 fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, shall be subject to the following
16 budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees, except as
17 may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of
18 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
