9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Department of
11 Commerce; requiring budgeting in certain categories
12 and amounts; requiring certain performance measures;
13 providing for duties and compensation of employees;
14 limiting salary of the Executive Director; providing
15 budgetary limitations; and providing an effective
16 date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the
18 Oklahoma Department of Commerce shall budget all funds in the
19 following categories and amounts:

4 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
5 each budget category.

6 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not
7 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
8 upon the Oklahoma Department of Commerce by law shall be set by the
9 Executive Director. The salary of the Executive Director of the
10 Oklahoma Department of Commerce shall not exceed _____
11 Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year
12 ending June 30, 2011. The Oklahoma Department of Commerce for the
13 fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, shall be subject to the following
14 budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and
15 expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special
16 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of
17 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
