8 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Conservation
11 Commission; making an appropriation; stating purpose;
12 requiring budgeting in certain categories and
13 amounts; requiring certain performance measures;
14 providing for duties and compensation of employees;
15 limiting salary of the Executive Director; providing
16 budgetary limitations; and providing an effective
17 date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma
20 Conservation Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated
21 from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal
22 year ending June 30, 2011, the sum of _____ Dollars
23 (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties
24 imposed upon the Oklahoma Conservation Commission by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the
2 Oklahoma Conservation Commission shall budget all funds in the
3 following categories and amounts:

12 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
13 each category.

14 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
15 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
16 upon the Oklahoma Conservation Commission by law shall be set by the
17 Oklahoma Conservation Commission. The salary of the Executive
18 Director of the Oklahoma Conservation Commission shall not exceed
19 _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the
20 fiscal year ending June 30, 2011. The Oklahoma Conservation
21 Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, shall be
22 subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-
23 equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for
24 capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant

1 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
2 Statutes:
