8 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Department of
11 Agriculture, Food, and Forestry; making an
12 appropriation; stating purpose; requiring budgeting
13 in certain categories and amounts; requiring certain
14 performance measures; providing for duties and
15 compensation of employees; limiting the salary of the
16 Commissioner; providing budgetary limitations; and
17 providing an effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma
20 Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry from any monies not
21 otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State
22 Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the sum of
23 _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary
24 to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Department of
Agriculture, Food, and Forestry by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the
 2 Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry shall budget
 3 all funds in the following categories and amounts:

19 each budget category.

20 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
21 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
22 upon the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry by
23 law shall be set by the State Board of Agriculture. The salary of
24 the Commissioner shall not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00)

1 per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010.
2 The Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry, for the
3 fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the following
4 budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and
5 expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special
6 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of
7 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
