AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Conservation  
Commission; requiring budgeting in certain categories  
and amounts; requiring certain performance measures;  
providing for duties and compensation of employees;  
limiting salary of the Executive Director; providing  
budgetary limitations; and providing an effective  
date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the  
Oklahoma Conservation Commission shall budget all funds in the  
following categories and amounts:

3 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for  
4 each category.

5 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
6 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
7 upon the Oklahoma Conservation Commission by law shall be set by the  
8 Oklahoma Conservation Commission. The salary of the Executive  
9 Director of the Oklahoma Conservation Commission shall not exceed  
10 \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the  
11 fiscal year ending June 30, 2011. The Oklahoma Conservation  
12 Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, shall be  
13 subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-  
14 equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for  
15 capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant  
16 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma  
17 Statutes:
