10 An Act relating to the Department of Environmental
Quality; making an appropriation; stating purpose;
11 requiring budgeting in certain categories and
amounts; requiring certain performance measures;
12 providing for duties and compensation of employees;
limiting salary of the Executive Director; providing
13 budgetary limitations; and providing an effective
date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of
18 Environmental Quality from any monies not otherwise appropriated
19 from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal
20 year ending June 30, 2011, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00)
21 or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed
22 upon the Department of Environmental Quality by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the
2 Department of Environmental Quality shall budget all funds in the
3 following categories and amounts:

13 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
14 each budget category.

15 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
16 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
17 upon the Department of Environmental Quality by law shall be set by
18 the Executive Director of the Department of Environmental Quality.
19 The salary of the Executive Director of the Department of
20 Environmental Quality shall not exceed _____ Dollars
21 (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June
22 30, 2011. The Department of Environmental Quality for the fiscal
23 year ending June 30, 2011, shall be subject to the following
24 budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and

1 expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special
2 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of
3 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
