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9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Horse Racing
11 Commission; making an appropriation; stating purpose;
12 requiring budgeting in certain categories and
13 amounts; requiring certain performance measures;
14 providing for duties and compensation of employees;
15 limiting the salary of the Director; providing
16 budgetary limitations; and providing an effective
17 date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Horse
20 Racing Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from
21 the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
22 ending June 30, 2011, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00)
23 or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed
24 upon the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the
2 Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission shall budget all funds in the
3 following categories and amounts:

10 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
11 each budget category.

12 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
13 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
14 upon the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission by law shall be set by the
15 Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed _____
16 Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year
17 ending June 30, 2011. The Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission for the
18 fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, shall be subject to the following
19 budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and
20 expenditures excluding expenditures from the Oklahoma Breeding
21 Development Revolving Fund, except as may be authorized pursuant to
22 the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
