9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Department of Labor; making an
11 appropriation; stating purpose; requiring budgeting
12 in certain categories and amounts; requiring certain
13 performance measures; providing for duties and
14 compensation of employees; providing budgetary
15 limitations; and providing an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of
18 Labor from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General
19 Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June
20 30, 2011, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof
21 as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the
22 Department of Labor by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the
2 Department of Labor shall budget all funds in the following
3 categories and amounts:

13 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
14 each budget category.

15 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
16 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
17 upon the Department of Labor by law shall be set by the Commissioner
18 of Labor. The Department of Labor for the fiscal year ending June
19 30, 2011, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on
20 full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding
21 expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be
22 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of
23 the Oklahoma Statutes:
