9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Will Rogers Memorial
11 Commission; making an appropriation; stating purpose;
12 requiring budgeting in certain categories and
13 amounts; requiring certain performance measures;
14 providing for duties and compensation of employees;
15 providing budgetary limitations; and providing an
16 effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Will Rogers
19 Memorial Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from
20 the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
21 ending June 30, 2011, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so
22 much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon
23 the Will Rogers Memorial Commission by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the Will
2 Rogers Memorial Commission shall budget all funds in the following
3 categories and amounts:

Museum Operations	\$0.00	\$0.00

6 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
7 the budget category.

8 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
9 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
10 upon the Will Rogers Memorial Commission by law shall be set by the
11 Will Rogers Memorial Commission. The Will Rogers Memorial
12 Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, shall be
13 subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-
14 equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for
15 capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant
16 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
17 Statutes:
