AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Department of  
Commerce; requiring budgeting in certain categories  
and amounts; requiring certain performance measures;  
providing for duties and compensation of employees;  
limiting salary of the Executive Director; providing  
budgetary limitations; and providing an effective  
date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the  
Oklahoma Department of Commerce shall budget all funds in the  
following categories and amounts:

2 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for  
3 each budget category.

4 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
5 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
6 upon the Oklahoma Department of Commerce by law shall be set by the  
7 Executive Director. The salary of the Executive Director of the  
8 Oklahoma Department of Commerce shall not exceed \_\_\_\_\_  
9 Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year  
10 ending June 30, 2010. The Oklahoma Department of Commerce for the  
11 fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the following  
12 budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and  
13 expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special  
14 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of  
15 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
