AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Department of Corrections;
requiring budgeting in certain categories and
amounts; requiring certain performance measures;
providing for duties and compensation of employees;
limiting the salary of the Director; authorizing
employment of certain percentage of employees in the
unclassified service; providing budgetary
limitations; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the
Department of Corrections shall budget all funds in the following
categories and amounts:

4 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
5 each budget category.

6 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not
7 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
8 upon the Department of Corrections by law shall be set by the
9 Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed _____
10 Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year
11 ending June 30, 2011. The Department of Corrections for the fiscal
12 year ending June 30, 2011, shall be authorized to employ up to six
13 percent (6%) of its total authorized full-time-equivalent employees
14 in the unclassified service and shall be subject to the following
15 budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and
16 expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special
17 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of
18 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
