AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the District Attorneys Council;  
requiring budgeting in certain categories and  
amounts; requiring certain performance measures;  
providing for duties and compensation of employees;  
providing budgetary limitations; and providing an  
effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the  
District Attorneys Council shall budget all funds in the following  
categories and amounts:

5 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for  
6 each budget category.

7 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
8 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
9 upon the district attorneys and District Attorneys Council by law  
10 shall be set by the district attorneys and the District Attorneys  
11 Council as provided by Section 215.35C of Title 19 of the Oklahoma  
12 Statutes. The district attorneys and District Attorneys Council for  
13 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, shall be subject to the  
14 following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees  
15 and expenditures, except as may be authorized pursuant to the  
16 provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
