AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma State Bureau of
Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control; requiring
budgeting in certain categories and amounts;
requiring certain performance measures; providing for
duties and compensation of employees; limiting salary
of the Director; providing budgetary limitations; and
providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the
Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control shall
budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

3 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
4 each budget category.

5 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not
6 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
7 upon the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs
8 Control by law shall be set by the Director. The salary of the
9 Director shall not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per
10 annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011.

11 The Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control
12 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, shall be subject to the
13 following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees,
14 except hours coded as overtime wages, and expenditures excluding
15 expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be
16 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of
17 the Oklahoma Statutes:
