9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Commission on Consumer Credit;  
11 making an appropriation; stating purpose; requiring  
12 budgeting in certain categories and amounts;  
13 requiring certain performance measures; providing for  
14 duties and compensation of employees; providing  
15 budgetary limitations; and providing an effective  
16 date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Commission on  
19 Consumer Credit from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the  
20 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year  
21 ending June 30, 2010, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars  
22 (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties  
23 imposed upon the Commission on Consumer Credit by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the  
2 Commission on Consumer Credit shall budget all funds in the  
3 following categories and amounts:

7 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for  
8 each budget category.

9 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
10 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
11 upon the Commission on Consumer Credit by law shall be set by the  
12 Director. The Commission on Consumer Credit, for the fiscal year  
13 ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the following budgetary  
14 limitations on full-time-equivalent employees, except as may be  
15 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of  
16 the Oklahoma Statutes:

18 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective September 1, 2009.
