8 AS INTRODUCED

9 An Act relating to the Department of Corrections;
10 making an appropriation; stating purpose; requiring
11 budgeting in certain categories and amounts;
12 requiring certain performance measures; providing for
13 duties and compensation of employees; limiting the
14 salary of the Director; authorizing employment of
15 certain percentage of employees in the unclassified
16 service; providing budgetary limitations; and
17 providing an effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of
20 Corrections from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
21 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
22 ending June 30, 2011, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or
23 so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed
24 upon the Department of Corrections by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the
2 Department of Corrections shall budget all funds in the following
3 categories and amounts:

12 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
13 each budget category.

14 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
15 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
16 upon the Department of Corrections by law shall be set by the
17 Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed _____
18 Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year
19 ending June 30, 2011. The Department of Corrections for the fiscal
20 year ending June 30, 2011, shall be authorized to employ up to six
21 percent (6%) of its total authorized full-time-equivalent employees
22 in the unclassified service and shall be subject to the following
23 budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and
24 expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special

1 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of
2 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

6 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective September 1, 2010.

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
