6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to public health and safety;  
8 directing the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to study  
9 the use of certain funding; directing the Authority  
10 to submit certain plan; requiring the inclusion of  
11 certain facilities into specified incentive program;  
12 providing for codification; and providing an  
13 effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5025.1 of Title 63, unless there  
17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall study the use of  
19 federal and state funding to retrofit nursing and specialized  
20 facilities, as those terms are defined in Section 1-1902 of Title 63  
21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, for portable generators to be utilized  
22 during emergency situations.

23 B. The Authority shall submit a funding plan to the Governor  
24 and the Legislature by September 30, 2011, that provides for  
incentives for nursing and specialized facilities to purchase or

1 retrofit generators for use during emergency situations. Facilities  
2 that have purchased or made improvements for emergency power  
3 capabilities within the previous eight (8) years shall be included  
4 in any incentive program.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
