6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S.
8 2001, Section 85.3A, as last amended by Section 11,
9 Chapter 433, O.S.L. 2009 (74 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section
10 85.3A), which relates to the Oklahoma Central
11 Purchasing Act; exempting city-county health
12 departments from the Oklahoma Central Purchasing Act;
and providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 85.3A, as
15 last amended by Section 11, Chapter 433, O.S.L. 2009 (74 O.S. Supp.
16 2009, Section 85.3A), is amended to read as follows:

17 Section 85.3A. Compliance with the provisions of The Oklahoma
18 Central Purchasing Act shall not be required of:

- 19 1. County government or any city-county health department;
- 20 2. The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education, the
21 institutions, centers, or other constituent agencies of The Oklahoma
22 State System of Higher Education;
- 23 3. The telecommunications network known as OneNet;
- 24 4. The Department of Public Safety gun range; or

1 5. The State Treasurer for the following purchases:

2 a. services, including, but not limited to, legal
3 services to assist in the administration of the
4 Uniform Unclaimed Property Act, as provided in Section
5 668 of Title 60 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and

6 b. software, hardware and associated services to assist
7 in the administration of funds and securities held by
8 the state, as provided in Section 7 of this act.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
