6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to professions and occupations;
8 amending 59 O.S. 2001, Section 1685, as amended by
9 Section 7, Chapter 4, O.S.L. 2008 (59 O.S. Supp.
10 2009, Section 1685), which relates to use of
11 electrical contractor license; making language gender
12 neutral; modifying language; and providing an
13 effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2001, Section 1685, as
16 amended by Section 7, Chapter 4, O.S.L. 2008 (59 O.S. Supp. 2009,
17 Section 1685), is amended to read as follows:

18 Section 1685. A. The Construction Industries Board shall issue
19 a license as journeyman electrician or electrical contractor to any
20 person who:

21 1. Has been certified by the Committee of Electrical Examiners
22 as either having successfully passed the appropriate examination or
23 having a valid license issued by another governmental entity with
24 licensing requirements similar to those provided in the Electrical
License Act;

1 2. Has paid the license fee and otherwise complied with the
2 provisions of the Electrical License Act; and

3 3. Has, when required by the Board, provided such documents,
4 statements or other information as may be necessary to submit to a
5 national criminal history record check as defined by Section 150.9
6 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

7 B. All licenses shall be nontransferable ~~and it.~~ It shall be a
8 misdemeanor for any person licensed under the provisions of the
9 Electrical License Act to loan or allow the use of ~~such~~ his or her
10 license by any other person, firm or corporation, except as
11 specifically provided in the Electrical License Act.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
