10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Historical Society;
11 requiring budgeting in certain categories and
12 amounts; requiring certain performance measures;
13 providing for duties and compensation of employees;
14 limiting salary of Executive Director and Deputy
15 Executive Director; providing budgetary limitations;
16 and providing an effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the
19 Oklahoma Historical Society shall budget all funds in the following
20 categories and amounts:

2 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
3 each budget category.

4 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not
5 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
6 upon the Oklahoma Historical Society by law shall be set by the
7 Executive Director of the Oklahoma Historical Society. The salary
8 of the Executive Director of the Oklahoma Historical Society shall
9 not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum and the salary of the
10 Deputy Executive Director of the Oklahoma Historical Society shall
11 not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for
12 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The Oklahoma Historical
13 Society for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject
14 to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent
15 employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and
16 special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the
17 provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
