6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to elections; amending 26 O.S. 2001,
8 Section 3-101, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter
9 224, O.S.L. 2005 (26 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section 3-101),
which relates to election dates; clarifying language;
and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2001, Section 3-101, as
14 last amended by Section 1, Chapter 224, O.S.L. 2005 (26 O.S. Supp.
15 2009, Section 3-101), is amended to read as follows:

16 Section 3-101. A. No election required to be conducted by any
17 county election board shall be scheduled for a day other than
18 Tuesday.

19 B. Except as otherwise provided by law, no special election
20 shall be held by any county, school district, technology center
21 school district, municipality or other entity authorized to call
22 elections except on the second Tuesday of January, February, May,
23 June, July, August, September, October, November and December and
24 the first Tuesday in March and April in odd-numbered years and the

1 second Tuesday of January, February, May, and December, the first
2 Tuesday in March and April, the last Tuesday in July, the fourth
3 Tuesday in August, and the first Tuesday after the first Monday in
4 November of any even-numbered year; ~~except~~ provided, in any year
5 when a Presidential Preferential Primary Election is held in
6 February, the date for the special elections shall be the same date
7 as the Presidential Preferential Primary Election.

8 C. In the event that a regular or special election date occurs
9 on an official state holiday, the election shall be scheduled for
10 the next following Tuesday.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
