AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Insurance Department; making an appropriation; stating purpose; requiring budgeting in certain categories and amounts; requiring certain performance measures; providing for duties and compensation of employees; providing budgetary limitations; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Insurance Department from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Insurance Department by law.

SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the Insurance Department shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

7 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
8 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
9 upon the Insurance Department by law shall be set by the Insurance
10 Commissioner. The Insurance Department, for the fiscal year ending
11 June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the following budgetary
12 limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures
13 excluding expenditures on capital and special projects, except as
14 may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of
15 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
