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6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to oil and gas; authorizing the
8 Corporation Commission to collect fee for commercial
9 disposal wells; stating fee; stating procedures;
10 stating uses for monies; providing for deposit in
11 certain fund; authorizing promulgation of rules;
12 providing for codification; and declaring an
13 emergency.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 139.1 of Title 52, unless there
17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. The Corporation Commission shall collect a fee of five cents
19 (\$0.05) for each barrel of fluid disposed of in a commercial
20 disposal well, as defined and regulated by the Commission.

21 B. The fee shall be paid quarterly by the operator of the
22 commercial disposal well. The fee shall be due on or before the
23 last day of the second month of each calendar quarter, beginning
24 with August 31, 2010, for the total volume of fluid disposed of in
the commercial disposal well during the previous quarter.

1 C. The Commission may expend monies collected pursuant to this
2 section only on the direct or indirect costs of regulating oil and
3 gas activities and operations within the Commission's jurisdiction.

4 D. Monies collected by the Commission pursuant to this section
5 shall be deposited in the Oil and Gas Revolving Fund.

6 E. The Commission is authorized to promulgate rules as
7 necessary to implement the provisions of this section.

8 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
9 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
10 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
11 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
