6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to counties and county officers;  
8 authorizing circuit engineering districts to  
9 establish County Energy District Authorities; stating  
10 procedures; providing for appointment of trustees and  
11 officers; providing for codification; and declaring  
12 an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 460.2a of Title 19, unless there  
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. The board of directors of a circuit engineering district,  
18 established pursuant to Section 687.1 et seq. of Title 69 of the  
19 Oklahoma Statutes, may by resolution, establish a County Energy  
20 District Authority pursuant to the provisions of this act, for the  
21 district. The authority shall be a public trust as provided for in  
22 Sections 176 through 180.3 of Title 60 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

23 B. The authority shall consist of five (5) trustees as follows:

24 1. Three members of the board of directors of the circuit  
engineering district; and

1        2. Two persons appointed by the board of directors of the  
2 circuit engineering district. The appointed members shall be  
3 residents of the district and shall not be elected officials.

4        C. The chair of the board of directors of the circuit  
5 engineering district shall serve as chair of the authority.

6        SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
7 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
