7 AS INTRODUCED

8 An Act relating to public safety; amending 47 O.S.
9 2001, Section 11-1001, as last amended by Section 1,
10 Chapter 222, O.S.L. 2004 (47 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section
11 11-1001), which relates to stopping, standing or
parking outside of business or residence district;
12 modifying punishment for certain violations; and
13 providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2001, Section 11-1001, as
16 last amended by Section 1, Chapter 222, O.S.L. 2004 (47 O.S. Supp.
17 2009, Section 11-1001), is amended to read as follows:

18 Section 11-1001. A. 1. Upon any highway outside of a business
19 or residence district no person shall stop, park or leave standing
20 any vehicle, whether attended or unattended, upon the paved or main-
21 traveled part of the highway when it is practicable to stop, park or
22 so leave such vehicle off such part of ~~said~~ the highway, but in
23 every event an unobstructed width of the highway opposite a standing
24 vehicle shall be left for the free passage of other vehicles and a

1 clear view of such stopped vehicles shall be available from a
2 distance of four hundred (400) feet in each direction upon such
3 highway.

4 2. As used in this section and Section 11-1002 of this title,
5 "highway" means any public road, street, or turnpike used for
6 vehicular travel.

7 B. 1. The owner or operator of a vehicle or its cargo which
8 obstructs the regular flow of traffic shall make every reasonable
9 effort to remove the obstructing vehicle or cargo from the roadway
10 so the regular flow of traffic is not blocked. This subsection
11 shall not apply to collisions resulting in the injury or death of
12 any person.

13 2. This subsection shall not apply to vehicles transporting
14 "hazardous materials" as defined in paragraph 5 of Section 230.3 of
15 this title.

16 3. Nothing in this subsection shall be construed to relieve any
17 person from complying with Section 10-103 of this title.

18 ~~4. a. Until January 1, 2006, any person violating this~~
19 ~~subsection may be issued a written warning of the~~
20 ~~violation.~~

22 C. Any person violating this subsection shall, upon conviction,
23 be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished as provided for in
24 Section 17-101 of this title.
