6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries;
8 designating certain memorial highways; requiring
9 permanent markers; providing for codification; and
10 providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.60 of Title 69, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 That portion of State Highway 32 where it begins in Kingston
17 west to the intersection of State Highway 377 in Madill shall be
18 designated as the "Corporal Michael Eyre Thompson Memorial Highway".
19 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent
20 markers to be placed upon the highway bearing that name.

21 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.61 of Title 69, unless
23 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 That portion of United States Highway 377 from the City of
2 Madill limits south to the Oklahoma State line shall be designated
3 as the "Sergeant Clint E. Williams Memorial Highway". The
4 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
5 to be placed upon the highway bearing that name.

6 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
7 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.62 of Title 69, unless
8 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

9 That portion of United States Highway 70 east from the Bryan
10 County line east to the City of Durant limits shall be designated as
11 the "Chief Warrant Officer Brady Rudolph Memorial Highway". The
12 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
13 to be placed upon the highway bearing that name.

14 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
