6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to health care; requiring the
8 Oklahoma Health Care Authority and the Oklahoma State
9 and Education Employees Group Insurance Board to not
reimburse hospitals for certain conditions; providing
for codification; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5028 of Title 63, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 Effective for contracts entered into on or after January 1,
17 2011, the Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall not reimburse
18 hospitals for the following hospital-acquired conditions:

- 19 1. Foreign object retained after surgery;
- 20 2. Wrong site surgery;
- 21 3. Air embolism;
- 22 4. Blood transfusion incompatibility;
- 23 5. Stage III and stage IV pressure ulcers;
- 24 6. Catheter-associated urinary tract infection;

- 1 7. Vascular catheter-associated infection;
- 2 8. Surgical site infection - mediastinitis after coronary
- 3 artery bypass graft;
- 4 9. Ventilator-associated pneumonia;
- 5 10. Latrogenic pneumothorax; and
- 6 11. Pulmonary embolism.

7 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
8 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1329 of Title 74, unless there
9 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

10 Effective for contracts entered into on or after January 1,
11 2011, The Oklahoma State and Education Employees Group Insurance
12 Board shall not reimburse hospitals for the following hospital-
13 acquired conditions:

- 14 1. Foreign object retained after surgery;
- 15 2. Wrong site surgery;
- 16 3. Air embolism;
- 17 4. Blood transfusion incompatibility;
- 18 5. Stage III and stage IV pressure ulcers;
- 19 6. Catheter-associated urinary tract infection;
- 20 7. Vascular catheter-associated infection;
- 21 8. Surgical site infection - mediastinitis after coronary
- 22 artery bypass graft;
- 23 9. Ventilator-associated pneumonia;
- 24 10. Latrogenic pneumothorax; and
