9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Scenic Rivers Commission;  
11 requiring budgeting in certain categories and  
12 amounts; requiring certain performance measures;  
13 providing for duties and compensation of employees;  
14 limiting salary of Administrator; providing budgetary  
15 limitations; and providing an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the Scenic  
18 Rivers Commission shall budget all funds in the following categories  
19 and amounts:

20 <u>Category</u>	<u>Appropriation</u>	<u>Total</u>
21 General Operations	\$0.00	\$0.00

22 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for  
23 each budget category.

1 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
2 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
3 upon the Scenic Rivers Commission by law shall be set by the  
4 Administrator of the Scenic Rivers Commission. The salary of the  
5 Administrator of the Scenic Rivers Commission shall not exceed  
6 \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the  
7 fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The Scenic Rivers Commission, for  
8 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the  
9 following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees  
10 and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special  
11 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of  
12 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

16 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective September 1, 2009.
