9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Tourism and
11 Recreation Department; making an appropriation;
12 stating purpose; requiring budgeting of certain funds
13 in certain categories and amounts; requiring certain
14 performance measures; providing for duties and
15 compensation of employees; limiting salary of the
16 Director; providing budgetary limitations; and
17 providing an effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Tourism
20 and Recreation Department from any monies not otherwise appropriated
21 from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal
22 year ending June 30, 2010, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so
23 much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon
24 the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the
 2 Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department shall budget all funds in
 3 the following categories and amounts:

3 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
4 each budget category.

5 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
6 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
7 upon the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department by law shall be
8 set by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Commission. The salary
9 of the Director shall not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per
10 annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010.
11 The Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department for the fiscal year
12 ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the following budgetary
13 limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures
14 excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as
15 may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of
16 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
