8 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Water Resources  
11 Board; making an appropriation; stating purpose;  
12 requiring budgeting in certain categories and  
13 amounts; requiring certain performance measures;  
14 providing for duties and compensation of employees;  
15 limiting salary of the Executive Director; providing  
16 budgetary limitations; and providing an effective  
17 date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Water  
20 Resources Board from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the  
21 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year  
22 ending June 30, 2010, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or  
23 so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed  
24 upon the Oklahoma Water Resources Board by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the  
2 Oklahoma Water Resources Board shall budget all funds in the  
3 following categories and amounts:

11 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for  
12 each budget category.

13 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
14 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
15 upon the Oklahoma Water Resources Board by law shall be set by the  
16 Oklahoma Water Resources Board. The salary of the Executive  
17 Director of the Oklahoma Water Resources Board shall not exceed  
18 \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the  
19 fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The Oklahoma Water Resources  
20 Board for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to  
21 the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent  
22 employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and  
23 special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the  
24 provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
