6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to elections; amending 26 O.S. 2001,  
8 Section 4-101, as amended by Section 3, Chapter 447,  
9 O.S.L. 2002 (26 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section 4-101),  
which relates to voter registration; making language  
gender neutral; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2001, Section 4-101, as  
14 amended by Section 3, Chapter 447, O.S.L. 2002 (26 O.S. Supp. 2009,  
15 Section 4-101), is amended to read as follows:

16 Section 4-101. Every person who is a qualified elector as  
17 defined by Section 1 of Article III of the Oklahoma Constitution  
18 shall be entitled to become a registered voter in the precinct of  
19 his or her residence, with the following exceptions:

20 1. Persons convicted of a felony shall be ineligible to  
21 register for a period of time equal to the time prescribed in the  
22 judgment and sentence.

23 2. Any person who has been adjudged to be an incapacitated  
24 person as such term is defined by Section 1-111 of Title 30 of the

1 Oklahoma Statutes, shall be ineligible to register to vote. When  
2 such incapacitated person has been adjudged to be no longer  
3 incapacitated such person shall be eligible to become a registered  
4 voter. The provisions of this paragraph shall not prohibit any  
5 person adjudged to be a partially incapacitated person as such term  
6 is defined by Section 1-111 of Title 30 of the Oklahoma Statutes  
7 from being eligible to register to vote unless the order adjudging  
8 the person to be partially incapacitated restricts such persons from  
9 being eligible to register to vote.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
