10 An Act relating to the Alcoholic Beverage Laws
11 Enforcement Commission; making an appropriation;
12 stating purpose; requiring budgeting in certain
13 categories and amounts; requiring certain performance
14 measures; providing for duties and compensation of
15 employees; limiting salary of the Director; providing
16 budgetary limitations; and providing an effective
17 date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Alcoholic
20 Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission from any monies not otherwise
21 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for
22 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the sum of _____
23 Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform
24 the duties imposed upon the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement
Commission by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the
2 Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission shall budget all
3 funds in the following categories and amounts:

11 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
12 each budget category.

13 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
14 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
15 upon the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission by law shall
16 be set by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed
17 _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the
18 fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The Alcoholic Beverage Laws
19 Enforcement Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010,
20 shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-
21 time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures
22 for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized
23 pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the
24 Oklahoma Statutes:
