6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to children; amending 10 O.S. 2001,
8 Section 601.30, as amended by Section 4, Chapter 421,
9 O.S.L. 2004 (10 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section 601.30),
10 which relates to the Board of Child Abuse
11 Examination; clarifying language; and providing an
12 effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 10 O.S. 2001, Section 601.30, as
15 amended by Section 4, Chapter 421, O.S.L. 2004 (10 O.S. Supp. 2009,
16 Section 601.30), is amended to read as follows:

17 Section 601.30. A. For the purpose of establishing a statewide
18 system to provide expert medical evaluation for children suspected
19 to be the victims of child abuse or neglect, there is hereby created
20 the Board of Child Abuse Examination within the Oklahoma Commission
21 on Children and Youth.

22 B. The Board shall consist of ten (10) members as follows:

23 1. The Director of the State Bureau of Investigation, or a
24 designee;

- 1 2. The State Commissioner ~~of the State Department~~ of Health, or
2 a designee;
- 3 3. The Director of the Department of Human Services, or a
4 designee;
- 5 4. The Director of the Oklahoma State District Attorneys
6 Association, or a designee;
- 7 5. The president of a statewide association of osteopathic
8 physicians, or a designee;
- 9 6. The president of a statewide association of allopathic
10 physicians, or a designee;
- 11 7. The Chief Executive Officer of the Oklahoma Health Care
12 Authority, or a designee;
- 13 8. The Executive Director of the Oklahoma Board of Nursing, or
14 a designee;
- 15 9. A representative of a statewide association of child
16 advocacy centers; and
- 17 10. The Chief Child Abuse Examiner provided for by Section
18 601.31 of this title. The Chief Child Abuse Examiner shall be a
19 nonvoting member of the Board.
- 20 C. 1. The Board shall annually elect one member to serve as
21 chair and one member to serve as vice-chair.
- 22 2. The members of the Board shall receive no compensation for
23 their services on the Board, but may be reimbursed pursuant to the
24 State Travel Reimbursement Act.

1 3. The Board shall meet not less than quarterly and may meet
2 more frequently as necessary, as determined by the chair. Six
3 members shall constitute a quorum.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.

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
