6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to public health and safety; amending
8 63 O.S. 2001, Section 1-1115, which relates to food
9 inspections; making language gender-neutral; and
10 providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2001, Section 1-1115, is
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 1-1115. The State Commissioner of Health or ~~his~~ the
15 Commissioner's duly-authorized agent shall have free access at all
16 reasonable hours to any factory, warehouse, or establishment in
17 which foods are manufactured, processed, packed, or held for
18 introduction into commerce, or to enter any vehicle being used to
19 transport or hold such foods in commerce after notice to the owner,
20 or person in charge of such factory, warehouse, establishment, or
21 vehicle, for the purpose:

22 ~~(1) of~~ 1. Of inspecting such factory, warehouse, establishment
23 or vehicle to determine if any of the provisions of this article are
24 being violated; and

1 ~~(2) to~~ 2. To secure samples or specimens of any food after
2 paying or offering to pay for such sample. It shall be the duty of
3 the Commissioner to make or cause to be made examinations of samples
4 secured under the provisions of this section to determine whether or
5 not any provision of this article is being violated; provided, that
6 a copy of the report thereof shall be furnished to the owner of such
7 factory, warehouse, establishment, or vehicle upon written request
8 to the Commissioner; and provided, further, that nothing in this
9 article shall be construed to limit, modify, repeal or affect in any
10 way the powers, duties or functions of the State Board of
11 Agriculture.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
