6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to crimes and punishments; making
8 persons and entities guilty of violating a specified
9 act guilty of a felony; providing for punishments;
providing for codification; and providing an
effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 358a of Title 21, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 Any person, firm, corporation, association or agency found
17 guilty of violating the Oklahoma Medicaid False Claims Act shall be
18 guilty of a felony punishable by a fine not exceeding Ten Thousand
19 Dollars (\$10,000.00), or by imprisonment in the custody of the
20 Department of Corrections for a term not exceeding two (2) years, or
21 by both such fine and imprisonment.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
