6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to professions and occupations;
8 exempting certain persons from licensing
9 requirements; providing for codification; providing
10 an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4002 of Title 59, unless there
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 The owner of property, or an owner's agent, who attempts to
16 determine cost estimates or various material options or secure a
17 detailed list of materials based upon a drawing or plan or any
18 professional source of written information for his or her
19 construction project shall not be held liable for the acts of, or
20 deemed to practice, a profession or trade required to be licensed in
21 this state.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.

23 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
24 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
