10 An Act relating to the Court of Criminal Appeals;
11 making an appropriation; stating purpose; requiring
12 budgeting in certain categories and amounts;
13 providing for duties and compensation of employees;
14 providing budgetary limitations; and providing an
15 effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Court of
18 Criminal Appeals from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
19 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
20 ending June 30, 2010, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or
21 so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed
22 upon the Court of Criminal Appeals by law.

23 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the Court
24 of Criminal Appeals shall budget all funds in the following
categories and amounts:

2	Court Operations	\$0.00	\$0.00

3 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
4 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
5 upon the Court of Criminal Appeals by law shall be set by the Judges
6 of the Court of Criminal Appeals. The Court of Criminal Appeals,
7 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the
8 following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees
9 and expenditures, except as may be authorized pursuant to the
10 provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

14 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective September 1, 2009.
