6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to professions and occupations;  
8 amending 59 O.S. 2001, Section 1681, as amended by  
9 Section 15, Chapter 439, O.S.L. 2009 (59 O.S. Supp.  
10 2009, Section 1681), which relates to rules for  
11 certain profession; modifying reference and language;  
12 clarifying rules for electrical contractors and  
13 journeymen electrician; providing an effective date;  
14 and declaring an emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2001, Section 1681, as  
17 amended by Section 15, Chapter 439, O.S.L. 2009 (59 O.S. Supp. 2009,  
18 Section 1681), is amended to read as follows:

19 Section 1681. The Construction Industries Board is hereby  
20 authorized to adopt, amend and repeal rules governing the electrical  
21 contractors and journeymen electricians as follows:

22 1. The examination and licensing of electrical contractors and  
23 journeymen electricians,~~the;~~

24 2. The defining of categories and limitations for such  
electrical contractor and journeymen electrician licenses,~~the;~~

1        3. The establishment of continuing education requirements and  
2 procedures as determined by the Committee of Electrical Examiners,  
3 ~~the;~~

4        4. The establishment and levying of administrative fines,~~the;~~

5        5. The initiation of disciplinary proceedings,~~the;~~

6        6. The requesting of prosecution of and initiation of  
7 injunctive proceedings against any person who violates any of the  
8 provisions of the Electrical License Act or any rule promulgated  
9 pursuant to the Electrical License Act,~~the;~~

10       7. The establishment of bonding and insurance requirements  
11 precluding municipal requirements,~~the;~~

12       8. The requirement of proof of possession of a Federal Tax ID  
13 Number and a State of Oklahoma Employment Security Board  
14 identification number,~~the;~~

15       9. The registration of electrical apprentices; and ~~the~~

16       10. The standard of electrical installations. Provided,  
17 broiler houses will not be required to meet the electrical wiring  
18 requirements for environmentally controlled poultry houses as set  
19 out in the National Electric Code.

20       SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.

21       SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
22 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
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1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
