5 AS INTRODUCED

6 An Act relating to intoxicating liquor; allowing
7 certain product sales between wineries; allowing sale
8 of bottled wine at different locations; providing for
codification; and providing an effective date.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 537.4 of Title 37, unless there
13 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any winery licensed
15 in this state to produce wine upon its premises may sell its bottled
16 wine product to another winery licensed in this state to produce
17 wine upon its premises, and in so selling bottled wine between
18 wineries, each winery agrees that any bottled wine product in its
19 possession may be sold to the public either upon the premises of the
20 winery or at another licensed location.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
