6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Corporation Commission;  
8 requesting the Commissioners to make certain report  
9 advising Legislature of activities relating to  
10 electric energy transmission; stating format of  
11 report and distribution; providing for  
12 noncodification; and declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
15 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

16 Pursuant to the provisions of Enrolled Senate Bill 827 of the  
17 1st Session of the 52nd Oklahoma Legislature, which authorized the  
18 Corporation Commission to contract with an electric transmission  
19 system advisor for the purpose of monitoring state, regional and  
20 federal activities relating to access to and reliability of the  
21 electric transmission system, the Oklahoma Legislature hereby  
22 requests the Corporation Commission to make a report, by any means  
23 it deems appropriate, of the activities and progress of such advisor  
24 and the current status of the Southwest Power Pool intention to  
authorize the construction of additional electric transmission

1 facilities in this state, especially those needed to transmit  
2 electric power derived from wind power facilities located in this  
3 state. If the Commission chooses to make such report in writing,  
4 the report shall be distributed to the President Pro Tempore of the  
5 Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives; should the  
6 Commission decide to report on such activities in person, the  
7 Commissioners may address the members of the Legislature in any  
8 Committee, either separately or jointly.

9 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
10 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
11 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
12 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
