5 AS INTRODUCED

6 An Act relating to state government; expanding scope
7 of power of the Native American Cultural and
8 Educational Authority regarding certain commercial
9 facilities; providing for codification; and providing
10 an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1226.4A of Title 74, unless
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 With respect to the planning, construction, development,
16 operation, maintenance, and administration of commercial facilities
17 which support, enhance, or contribute to the American Indian
18 Cultural Center, the Native American Cultural and Educational
19 Authority, notwithstanding any other provision of law, may exercise
20 all its powers without any other approval from any other public
21 entity, except as may otherwise be required by contract.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
