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6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to insurance; requiring a health
8 benefit plan to utilize a value-based insurance
9 design for the treatment of diabetes; specifying
10 components of the design; defining term; providing
11 for codification; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6060.20 of Title 36, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. Any health benefit plan that is offered, issued or renewed
17 on or after January 1, 2011, that provides medical and surgical
18 benefits shall utilize a value-based insurance design to offer a
19 plan for the benefit of an insured diagnosed with Type I or Type II
20 diabetes.

21 1. The design shall provide that there will not be co-pays or
22 deductibles for an insured diagnosed with Type I or Type II diabetes
23 who selects and utilizes as the primary physician for the treatment
24 of diabetes a physician who achieves Diabetes Recognition Program

1 recognition as certified by the National Committee Quality
2 Association.

3 2. There shall be enhanced reimbursement for physicians who
4 achieve Diabetes Recognition Program recognition as certified by the
5 National Committee Quality Association which is consistent with the
6 Bridges to Excellence guidelines.

7 B. As used in this section, "health benefit plan" means any
8 plan or arrangement as defined in subsection C of Section 6060.4 of
9 Title 36 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.

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
